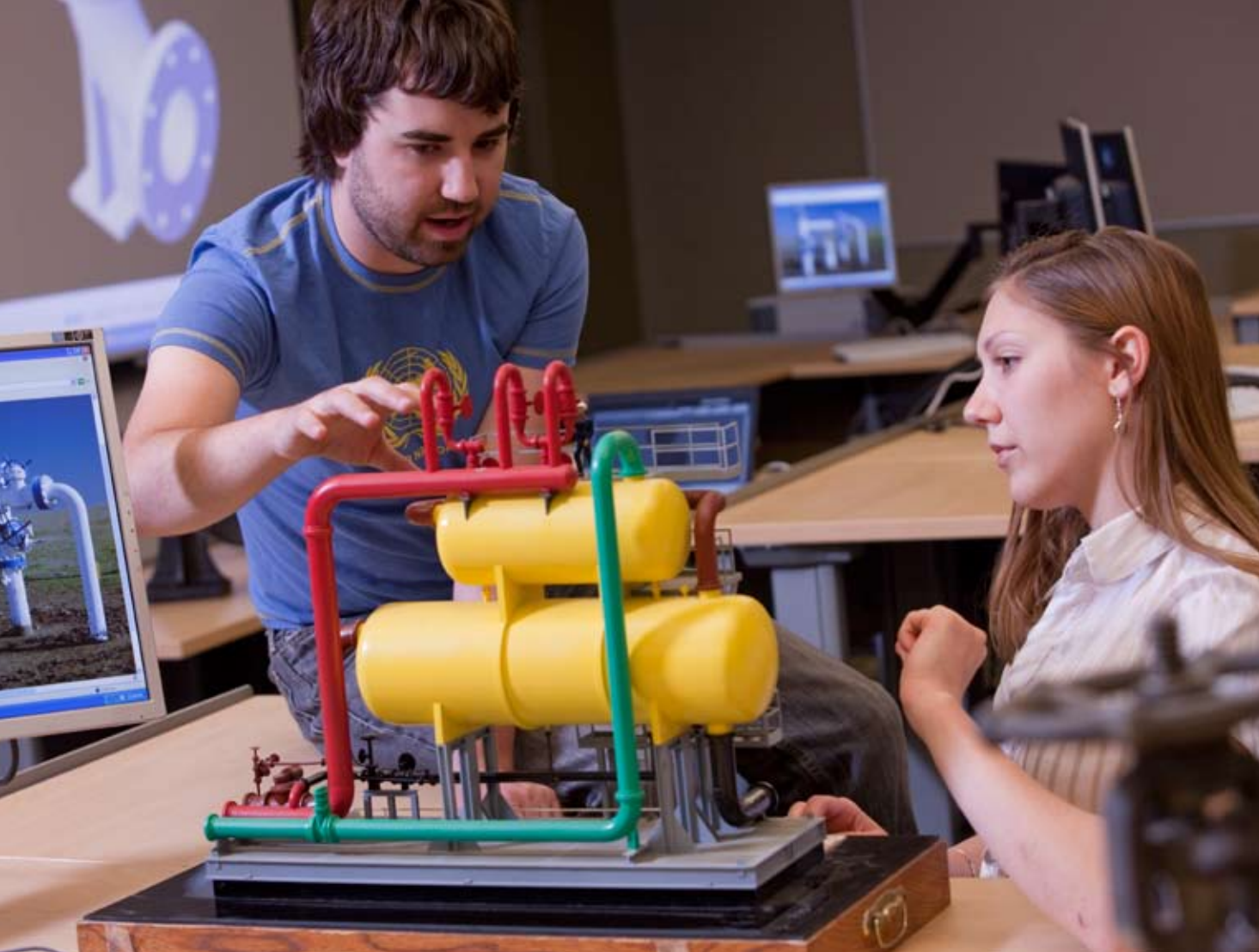

## ZHONGYONG LI IN PURSUIT OF PASSION

In China, Zhongyong Li was an electrical engineer. When he moved to Canada, he made it his mission to continue pursuing that passion – a pursuit that did not come without hard work and dedication.

Before Li could continue his studies in Canada, he had to take on the enormous task of learning the English language. Li’s dedication and perseverance paid off – he is now in his second year of SAIT’s Electrical Engineering Technology program.

“In my heart I want to be an electrical engineer, like I was in China,” said Li. “Becoming an electrical engineering technologist is a very good start for me here in Canada.”

Li’s strong desire to be a lifelong learner is one of the characteristics that made him the perfect candidate and winner of the TransAlta Scholarship Endowment award.

This spring I have already had two interviews directly related to my field of study, and I am not even finished my program yet.”
