New Programs:

Bachelor of Business Administration - Accounting

The Bachelor of Business Administration - Accounting (BBA) is an industry-recognized program designed to meet the demand for baccalaureate level accounting professionals.

The program differs from traditional Bachelor of Commerce degrees in that graduates will have the opportunity to complete all requisite core business and accounting courses needed to enter three professional programs: Chartered Accountant (CA), Certified General Accountant (CGA), and Certified Management Accountant (CMA).

There will be 64 seats offered for fall 2011.

Admission requirements:

Alberta High School Diploma or equivalent with at least 65% in each of the following courses or their equivalents: Pure Math 30, English Language Arts 30, two courses from Group A and one course from Group A or B.

Group A (Academics)

Mathematics 31
Biology 30
Chemistry 30

Physics 30
Science 30
Social Studies 30-1
30-level Language

Group B (Other) (5 credit)

Art 30 or 31
Drama 30
Music 30(choral, instrumental, general)
Physical Education 30
Religion 35
Social Studies 30-2
Other five-credit grade 12 subjects or a combination of two three-credit grade 12 subjects.
