Position Description

The Study Abroad office develops and delivers a range of international mobility opportunities to students including short-term group exchanges, faculty-led group study programs and semester exchanges. The Study Abroad office supports SAIT students with finding exchange opportunities abroad, pre-departure preparation, in-field support, and their transition back to campus. In addition, the Study Abroad team coordinates and hosts inbound programs for students and staff/faculty from international partner institutions.

Study Abroad is looking for a dynamic and dedicated student to assist with the support, delivery, and promotion of Study Abroad programs and events. Student leaders play an important role in the team and the operation of the office by helping organize and execute programs, projects and promotional activities.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Support the design and delivery of promotional activities, such as:
 - content creation for social media channels,
 - classroom presentations,
 - poster design and distribution,
 - assist with info sessions and pre-departure orientations,
 - host promotional booths and displays at SAIT events.
- Conduct research regarding study abroad best practices, potential destinations and innovative programming.
- Help host inbound exchange program participants to the SAIT campus, Calgary and several tourist locations. Hosting duties may include daytrips to Banff, Lake Louise, Drumheller, etc.
- Participate in weekly student leadership team meetings and activities.
- Attend student leadership training and any other relevant professional development and training sessions.
- Engage in other duties as opportunities allow.
