Supply chain management plan, organize, direct, control and evaluate the activities of a purchasing department and develop and implement the purchasing policies of a business or institution

Supply chain managers work mostly in an office setting but will sometimes visit sites that may require steel-toed boots and be exposed to loud or distracting noise levels. They usually work 40 hours a week however overtime is common during project deadlines. Typically, they have a set schedule of Monday to Friday but may be needed to work evening and weekends at busier times.









The Apple Juice

Drag the parts of the <u>bottle</u> supply chain into the correct order:


















Weighted centre



Aldred Community Business Report



Skilled Workforce

Aldred has an overall population of 120,000. Despite being a small city, it has a very skilled workforce, especially in the manufacturing, transportation, and retail sectors. Labour costs are 10-15% lower in Aldred than in SAITCity.

Highway Proximity

Aldred is located off of a major highway. Eastbound and westbound shipping are easily accessible, but northbound and southbound shipping is less accessible. Access to both directions for shipping is preferred.

Cost of Buying Land

The cost of real estate in Aldred is approximately 70% of the cost of land in SAITCity. The money saved on purchasing land can be spent on building state-of-the-art facilities.

Skilled Workforce

SAITCity has an overall population of 2,500,000. Since it has a large population, access to a skilled workforce is very high. Companies working in the manufacturing, transportation, and technology sectors tend to have an excellent selection of high-quality employees. On the other hand, employees expect higher wages in SAITCity than they do in smaller communities.

Highway Proximity

SAITCity is located off of a major highway. Northbound and southbound shipping is very accessible, but eastbound and westbound shipping is less accessible. Access to both directions for shipping is preferred.

Cost of Buying Land

The cost of real estate in SAITCity is the highest of any city in Western SAIT other than Crandell. There is a small chance business may find an existing facility and save on building their own.
